Support our local Farmers' Market, promote your organization, reach new customers and build a local following. Each week of the Waterdown Farmers' Market season, there is one Community Tent available for local business organizations.

### **Community Tent Benefits:**

- A large number of local shoppers visit the Waterdown Farmers' Market each Saturday (on average 800+ adults)
- Exclusivity only one community tent per Saturday
- A chance to **promote your organization** with handouts and samples (selling of goods or services is not permitted unless specific criteria are met and approved by the Market Committee)
- Additional promotion the Farmers' Market is promoted on the Waterdown BIA's website, the Waterdown Farmers' Market website, as well as through our social media websites including Facebook, Twitter and Instagram

#### **Community Tent Details**

- The Waterdown Farmers' Market takes place every Saturday from the end of May until mid-October in the front parking lot of the Waterdown Legion, 79 Hamilton St. N.
- We supply a 10' by 10' tent, an 8' table and two chairs, which are provided and set up by market staff
- Organizations are encouraged to use interesting and visual displays (banners, signs, promotional material, etc.) to merchandise their organization
- Organizations should be ready to receive customer inquiries by 8:00 am and stay until Market closes at 1:00 pm.
